FUN FACTS

- The **hump** on a moose's back is caused by the massive shoulder muscles needed to hold up their big head and antlers.
- Moose hair is **hollow**, which helps insulate them in the cold winters.
- Moose are able to close their nostrils under water.
- The dangling flap under a male moose's chin is called a **dewlap**.
- WATCH OUT! If a moose points its ears backward, stomps the ground or raises the hair on its hump, it means it is getting agitated.
