FUN FACTS

- Meadow jumping mice have long hind legs that help them jump great distances.
- In 1899 one scientist documented that they can jump 6-8 feet when startled. Other sources say they can jump 2-3 feet. Either way, that's a big jump for a roughly 4-inch rodent!
- Meadow jumping mice are also great climbers, diggers and swimmers.
- They can dive and stay underwater for 30-60 seconds.
